

NO WAY MY CAT HAS FLEAS

MY CAT DOES NOT GO OUTSIDE

My cat is scratching, pulling out its fur, there are little bumps on the skin, my cat is miserable what could be wrong? *It is possible your cat has fleas.*

No way my cat has fleas, my cat does not go outside. *But you do. You can bring fleas in the house on your pants leg or shoes. Even the most protective pet owner with the cleanest house in town can get fleas. Fleas do not discriminate.*

So what can you do? We recommend a flea treatment that you get from your veterinarian or local pet store. Do not purchase a flea treatment from a grocery store, etc. Those flea treatments may say for a cat, but we have found that the treatment can be too strong and could make your cat sick. Plus they do not work well.

We carry, Revolution, Frontline, and Advantage Flea Treatment. Frontline also treats ticks. If your cat is having a flea problem then you are probably having a problem in your home.

You must also treat your home as well as your cat. We recommend that you treat your cat with flea treatment at least 3 months in a row to break the cycle. However, treating your cat monthly is not a bad thing. Especially here in our area where the winters are not always harsh.

Be sure you treat the environment (your home) or you may be wasting your money and time by just treating your cat with flea treatment.
