

Suggestion To Help Rid Your Cat and House of Fleas

- 1. Treat your cat each month with a flea treatment such as Revolution Flea Treatment which kills fleas some ticks and helps prevent heartworms, ear mites, hookworms and roundworms. There is also Frontline Flea Treatment which kills fleas and ticks and Advantage Flea Treatment which kills fleas.***
- 2. For a bad case of fleas on your cat, you can also give a pill called a Capstar. This pill will kill adult fleas and ticks that may be on your cat. This pill starts to work 30 minutes after giving it to your cat, but will only work for 24 hours. Therefore you must put the flea treatment on your cat as well.***
- 3. You must also treat the enviroment (inside of your home) where the cat lives. Buy a flea treatment spray, or flea bomb that has a INSECT GROWTH REGULATOR (GR). We have a product called Siphotrol which contains the growth regulator and can be sprayed on carpet, furniture, curtains, and pet bedding. DO NOT SPRAY ON CAT. Follow directions on the container.***
- 4. Put a flea collar in your vaccuum cleaner bag or canister. Vaccuum the carpet, rugs, furniture etc. Do not empty bag or canister right away. Leave as is for a few days to give the flea collar time to work and kill the fleas. You may want to vaccuum several times to make sure that you have gotten a good handle on the fleas.***
- 5. Use a flea comb (these are combs where the teeth are close together) on your cat. This comb will help get live as well as dead fleas and flea dirt off of your cat.***

The above are just some suggestions to hopefully help you get your flea situation under control. Of course there is no guarantee that all of the above will work but it sure is worth a try. HERE'S TO HAPPY FLEA CONTROL!!!!
